**AMENDMENT TO ORDINANCE NO. 01-2010**

BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED that Greenup County Ordinance No. 01-2010 is hereby amended as follows:


WHEREAS, the Greenup County MS4 Group has produced an analysis of Rainfall Records from the Ashland, KY Weather Recording Station, COOPID No. 15-0254-04 as the Climate Data Station located the nearest to the MS4 Boundary. The analysis was produced for 48 years of records from January 1, 1962 through December 31, 2010.

The 80<sup>th</sup> Percentile determination from the Rainfall Records has yielded a runoff depth of 0.42 inches, which shall become the design requirement for use in the design of Water Quality Control Structures dedicated to contain and treat the flow from this runoff event to meet the required contaminate removal prior to off-site discharge.

The initial 0.42 inches of runoff from all storm events shall pass through the approved Water Quality BMPs permitted for the development activity, and the performance of the BMPs shall meet the treatment standards as established herein.


Structural and non-structural BMPs shall be provided in combination to contain the 0.42 inch runoff volume from the developed or re-developed area utilizing measures designed, constructed, and maintained to treat, filter, flocculate, infiltrate, screen, evapo-transpire, harvest and reuse stormwater runoff, or otherwise manage the stormwater runoff quality as indicated herein.

GIVEN SECOND READING, APPROVED, ADOPTED AND PASSED at the regular meeting of the Fiscal Court of Greenup County, Kentucky, held on the 15<sup>th</sup> day of October, 2013.
